PLANNED AIRBORNE SURVEY – OLD MOUNT PEAKE, NT

Aurium Resources Ltd (“Aurium”) is pleased to announce it has contracted the services of GPX Airborne Services Pty Ltd (“GPX”) to complete an aeromagnetic (TMI) and radiometric airborne survey on granted tenement EL25735 – Old Mount Peake.

GPX will use a fixed winged aircraft during the airborne survey. The survey will be flown in a north – south direction using 100m-line spacing, for a total of 4,338 line kilometres. A map showing the location of the tenement is attached.

Old Mt Peake is part of the Tennant West Uranium and Gold Project and is located 250km north of Alice Springs, NT. In the early 1990s this province tended to be explored by superficial methods of soil and rock chip sampling. Using this style of exploration, anomalous gold and uranium samples were reported on the contiguous Conical Hill lease to the east.

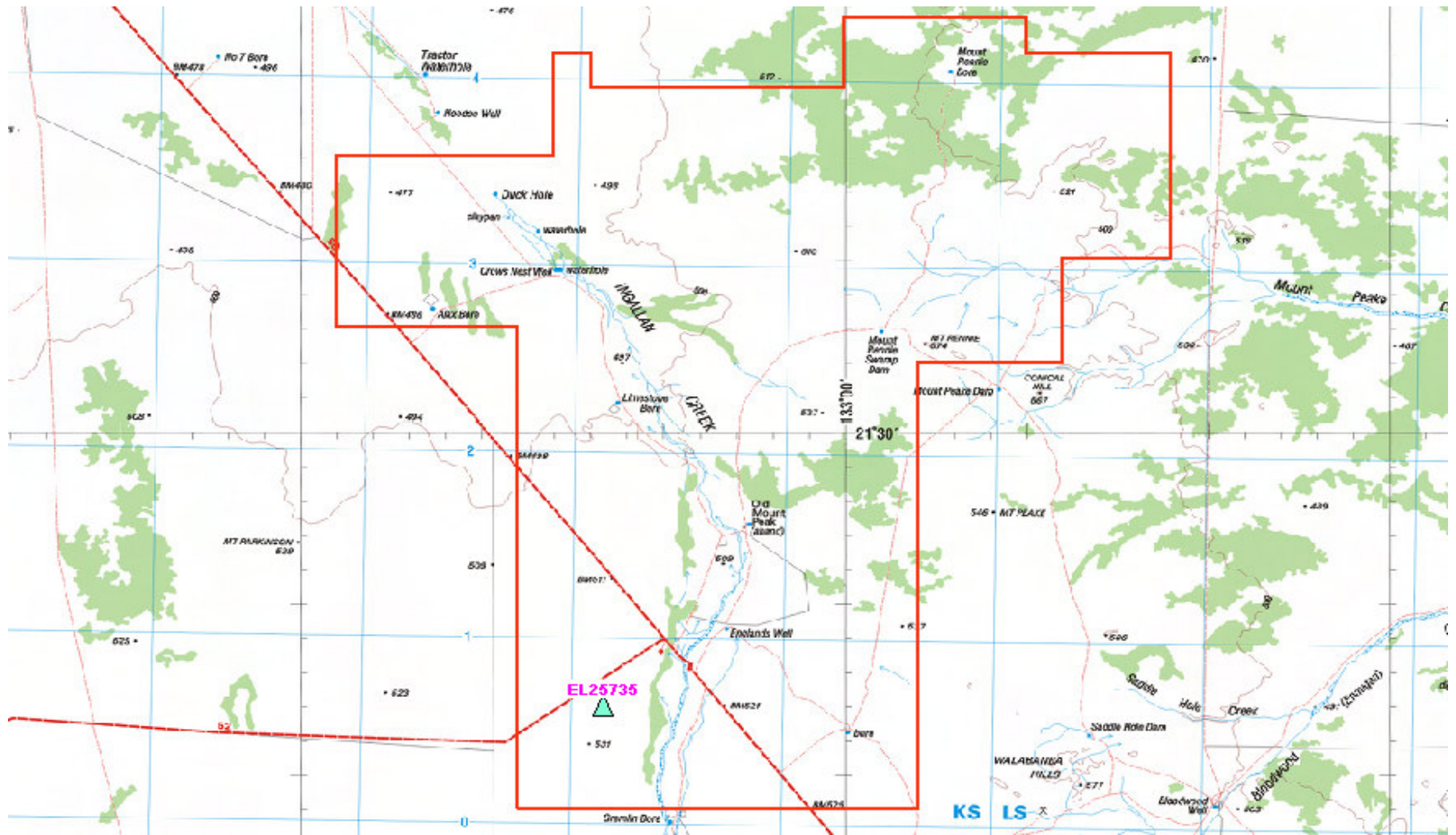
This mineral field has yielded substantial quantities of gold (5.5 million ozs) and copper (475,000 tonnes). Gold and base metal production and discoveries continue and specialist uranium companies are now seriously exploring the area, subjecting all prospective tenements to comprehensive exploration programs.

GPX are scheduled to commence the survey during this week and the Company’s consulting geologist, Mr Brian Davis, shall process the data once it comes available.

The company will announce the findings of the airborne survey to the market on completion of the geologist’s report, which should be available during this quarter.
